

MARKET REVIEW

- The fiscal borrowing program began with the issuance of a new 10Y benchmark Government of India bond yielding 7.80%.
- WPI inflation for March 2011 rose sharply above expectations to 8.98%, dampening sentiments and raising likelihood of stronger action by RBI.
- Post end of fiscal FY2010-11, Bank CD rates eased across the curve.
- The 50 bps hike in repo rate by the RBI on May 3, 2011 while warranted, was contrary to the past baby steps approach of the RBI.

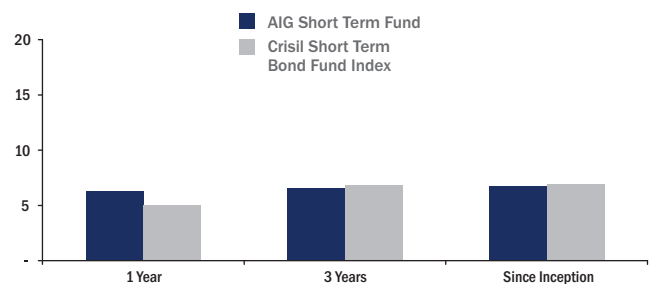

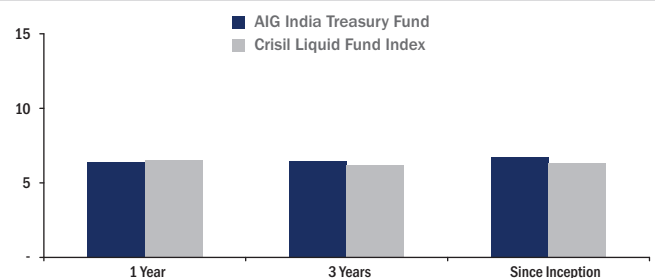

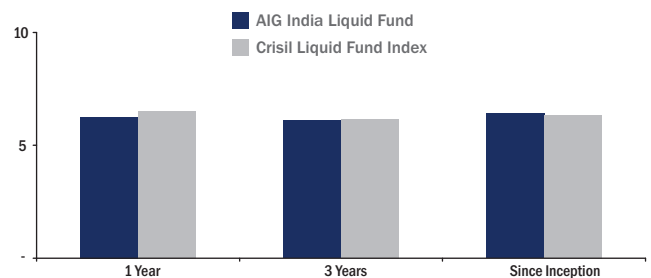
