

MARKET REVIEW

- The hike in repo and reverse repo rates by the Reserve Bank of India was on expected lines.
- Lack of Government Securities auction and lower than expected borrowing programme for FY2011-12 supported the yields on Government Securities.
- On account of the seasonal advance tax outflows and fiscal year-end concerns, the shorter end of the curve remained in focus with Bank Certificate of Deposits (CDs) being issued upwards of 10%.

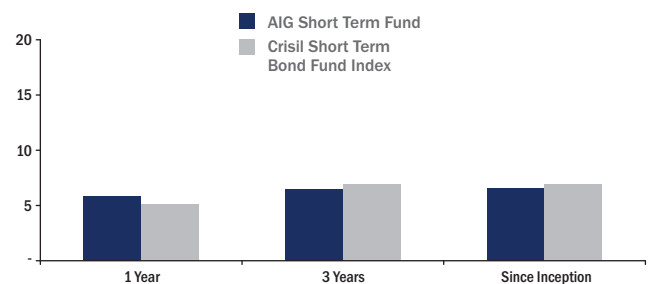

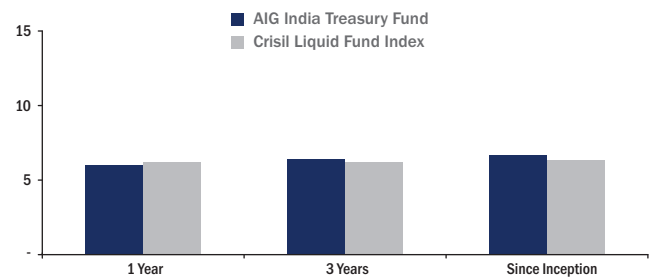

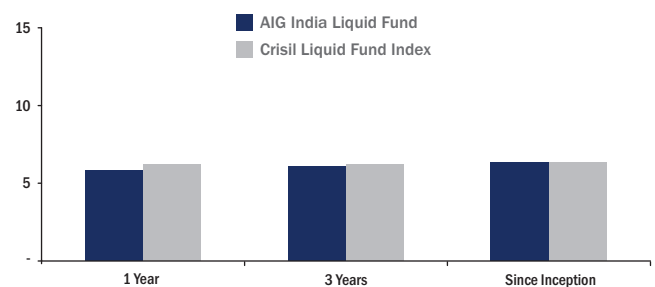
